The COVID-19 crisis is exposing the limitations of current approaches in U.S. board oversight of worker health and safety and demonstrating the risks these gaps pose to shareholders. Join us for an informative webinar on Wednesday 27 May at 4pm BST to hear from frontline workers at Walmart, the largest employer in the United States. Workers will share findings from their new report illustrating the breakdown in communication and information flow between the board, senior management, and essential frontline workers, and share their perspective on why worker representation on Walmart's board of directors is an essential reform for protecting worker safety, managing COVID-related risks, and promoting long-term shareholder value.

Shareholders will have an opportunity to support this effort by voting on Proposal 7, a resolution calling for worker board representation ahead of Walmart's June 3rd AGM, a vote for which PIRC has recommended support.
